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A Morphological Analysis of Affixes in Taylor Swift Song Lyrics "Blank Space"

The paper also explains the words and sentences contain prefixes, suffixes, and infixes. How many suffix, prefix, and infix in this song. The song presents a narrative that explores themes of love, obsession, and self awareness, all of which are articulated through carefully chosen words and phrases. In linguistic studies, the structure of words and their internal construction, know as morphology provides insight into how meaning is encoded with language. Morphology research the form and formation of words, including aspect such as root

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words, affixes (prefixes and suffixes), and grammatical inflections. Understanding the morphological structure of a text can reveal patterns in word formation and usage, highlighting how artists use language to construct meaning and convey emotion. This article aims to analyse the morphological elements found in the lyrics blank space, focusing on how swift's choice of words enhances the thematic depth of the song.

By examining the morphemes (the smallest unit of meaning) show in the lyrics, the study seeks of roots, prefixes, and suffixes put up to the overall semantic richness of the song. More ever, this analysis will rove the part word formation in expressing the dichotomy between exposure and control, furthermore is central to the song's narrative. The analysis of song lyrics from a morphological perspective not only enriches our understanding of the linguistic aspects of modern pop music but also highlights how language, as a creative tool, is manipulated to evoke specific emotional responses in listeners. By focusing on the word structure in "Blank Space". This study augment to comprehensive discussions on the intersection of linguistics and music, notably in the power of popular culture.

When people listen to the songs, they both enjoy the melody and also lyrics of the songs. To young generation, for example, songs occupy a very important space in their lives (Campo, 2020) such as from altering moods, shaping aspects related to personal identity to strengthening interpersonal relationships. Bull (2011) mentions that lyrics are parts of discourse that consists of words and sentences with different grammatical functions.

This article focuses on the works of Taylor Alison Swift. As a well - known influential American singer with numerous achievements, Taylor Swift is a figure worthy of study. She is one of the best- selling artists of all time, having sold more than 40 million albums including 27.1 million in the US and 130 million single downloads (Gordon, 2017).

In 2015, Swift became the youngest woman ever to be included on the Forbes "100 Most Powerful Women" list, ranking at number 64 (Gordon, 2017). RESULT AND DISCUSSION

Affix Identification: Each word in the song was analyzed to identify any prefixes, suffixes, infixes, and circumfixes.

Analysis: Each word in the song was examined individually to identify affixes. This involved breaking down words into their base forms and noting any prefixes (e.g., "un-", "re-"), suffixes (e.g., "-ing", "-ed"), infixes.

Use of Reference Materials: A dictionary and other linguistic reference materialswere used to veri fy and accurately classify each identified affix.

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Categorization: Identified affixes were categorized according to their type (e.g., prefix, suffix) and f unction (e.g., derivational, inflectional).

Classification by Type:

Identified affixes were grouped based on their type:

Prefixes (e.g., "un-", "dis-")

Suffixes (e.g., "-ing", "-ed")

Infixes and Circumfixes (less common in English but noted if present)

Function Analysis:

Each affix was further analyzed to determine its function:

Derivational Affixes: Those that change the meaning or part of speech of the base word (e.g., "ha ppy" to "unhappy").

Inflectional Affixes: Those that modify a word's tense, number, aspect, mood, or case without changing its core meaning (e.g., "walk" to "walked").

The frequency and distribution of each type of affix were analyzed to determine patterns and stylistic choices.

Frequency Count: The number of occurrences of each type of affix was counted and tabulated.

Pattern Detection: Patterns in the use of affixes were identified, such as recurring prefixes or suffixes and their role in the lyrics.

Interpretation: The results were interpreted to understand Taylor Swift's stylistic choices in affix usage within "Blank Space." This included examining how affixes contribute to the song's themes and emotional impact.

Selection of Source:

The lyrics of Taylor Swift's song "Blank Space" were sourced from <u>Genius.com</u>, a widely recogniz ed and reliable database for song lyrics. Genius is known for its community-verified lyrics, which ensures high accuracy.

Affix Identification:

Step 1: Classification by Type

- 1. Prefixes: Identify and list all prefixes found in the lyrics.
- 2. Suffixes: Identify and list all suffixes.
- 3. Infixes: Note any infixes, though they're rare in English.

Step 2: Function Analysis

- 1. Derivational Affixes: These change the meaning or part of speech of the base word (e.g., "u n-" in "unhappy" changes "happy" to "not happy").
- 2. Inflectional Affixes: These modify a word's tense, number, aspect, mood, or case without ch anging its core meaning (e.g., "-ed" in "walked" indicates past tense).

Step 3: Frequency Count

1. Count the occurrences of each type of affix in the lyrics. This helps in understanding the prominence and stylistic choices in the song.

Step 4: Pattern Detection

1. Analyze the patterns in the use of affixes. For example, frequent use of certain prefixes or suffixes might indicate a specific stylistic or thematic choice by the artist.

Let's categorize the prefix "in-" in "incredible":

- 1. Type: Prefix
- 2. Function: Derivational (changes the meaning to "not credible")
- 3. Frequency: Occurs once in the lyrics
- 4. Pattern: Used to emphasize the extraordinariness in the song's narrative.

Example: Prefix "mis-" in "mistake"

- 1. Type: Prefix
- 2. Function: Derivational (changes the meaning to "wrongly taken")
- 3. Frequency: Occurs once
- 4. Pattern: Emphasizes the concept of error or wrong judgment in the narrative.

Example: Suffix "-less" in "breathless"

- 1. Type: Suffix
- 2. Function: Derivational (turns "breath" into "without breath")
- 3. Frequency: Appears once
- 4. Pattern: Used to express extreme emotional or physical state.

Example: Suffix "-ful" in "playful"

- 1. Type: Suffix
- 2. Function: Derivational (turns "play" into "full of play")
- 3. Frequency: Occurs once
- 4. Pattern: Describes a characteristic, adding to the vivid description in the lyrics.

In this section, we delve into the identified affixes from Taylor Swift's "Blank Space" and interpret their significance and impact on the song's narrative.

Prefixes:

- 1. "in-" in "incredible": This derivational prefix emphasizes the extraordinariness of the described things, enhancing the song's imagery.
- 2. "mis-" in "mistake": This derivational prefix indicates a wrong action, contributing to the theme of flawed relationships and errors in judgment.
- 3. "ex-" in "ex-lovers": This derivational prefix indicates past relationships, central to the song's narrative about past love affairs.

Suffixes:

1. "-s" in "lovers" and "ends": These inflectional suffixes denote plurality, highlighting the multiplicity of relationships and story endings.

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- 2. "-less" in "breathless": This derivational suffix transforms "breath" into "without breath," vividly describing the overwhelming impact of emotions.
- 3. "-ing" in "dying": This inflectional suffix indicates a continuous action, adding a sense of urgency and immediacy to the anticipation of the story's outcome.

The frequent use of these affixes underscores Taylor Swift's mastery in crafting lyrics that resonate deeply with listeners. By strategically employing both derivational and inflectional affixes, Swift enriches her storytelling, making her music both linguistically and emotionally compelling. This analysis highlights how Swift's use of affixes not only enhances the narrative but also creates a more immersive and relatable experience for the audience. From this research related from the table, the author found 7 prefix, 8 suffixes, and 0 infix.

CONCLUSION

To summarize, this study has conducted a morphological analysis of the affixes in the lyrics of 'Blank Space' by Taylor Swift, placing an emphasis on the composed nature and role of certain affix types. From the analysis of the lyrics of the songs by the Bantu singers and songwriters, it was apparent that there was a great number of derivational morphemes as a great number of new words were created and contributed a lot to the theme of the song and its artistry. The attachment of the morphemes not only determined the grammatical structure of the song lyrics but also developed the meaning, opening the way of looking at the song in a different perspective, which is about love, fame, and heartbreak. In this regard, the study also seeks to understand how morphemic forms are constructed and structured combined with the social issues in the lyrical content.
